## **Teacher of History**

### **Commencing Semester 2, 2020 (13 July)**

A part-time position commencing Term 3, 2020 will be available for the remainder of the 2020 school year. The position will involve teaching Year 7 History which has seven 50-minute lessons a fortnight.

In addition, for the first five weeks of Term 3, to cover a member of staff on leave, a further five lessons a fortnight teaching Year 9 History could be added to the successful applicant.

*The Hamilton and Alexandra College has a strong academic programme within a broad and balanced curriculum. This is a short-term position which will be ongoing until we undertake curriculum restructuring in 2021.*

The successful applicant will be expected to teach the range of year levels listed above and be:

- passionate and enthusiastic about their subject area
- an individual member of the HTAV (or willing to join)
- able to share their passion and enthusiasm with their students
- fully qualified and registered to teach in a Victorian School. The applicant must have VIT teacher registration or interstate equivalent. Teachers without registration cannot be considered.
- a full and up to date police check is required for all candidates
- available for commencement of full duties at the commencement of the second semester of the 2020 school year (Monday July 13).

All staff are expected to be involved the school's extra-curricular program. A mentor is assigned for all newly appointed teachers at The Hamilton and Alexandra College.
